

## Qualifications of Your Evaluators

As an applicant, please choose two evaluators: one advanced clinical social worker\* and one advanced clinical social worker or clinical psychologist (doctoral level) or psychiatrist (M.D. or D.O.) who must be a current or former colleague, supervisor, or consultant. In the Application Kit, tell us whom you have chosen to judge your abilities as a specialist in clinical supervision. Be sure to print out two copies of the "Evaluator Package" to hand to your chosen Evaluators.

\* Characteristics - Master's or Doctoral degree in social work; at least five years of post-graduate clinical social work practice, including two years under supervision; current in practice (3,000 hours in the past 10 years); state licensure in good standing at the highest clinical level available in state(s) where you practice (unless exempted by law or terms of government employment).

**An Evaluator** has direct knowledge of your specialty practice and is a **Colleague, Supervisor, or Consultant** as described below:

- ❖ **Colleague:** in peer group of supervisors or works/worked with you and is familiar with your supervisory practice
- ❖ **Supervisor:** formally supervised your clinical practice
- ❖ **Consultant:** consulted your supervisory practice or, in the instance of your supervising students, was a field liaison or faculty advisor.

**An Evaluator** must have at least one full year of direct knowledge (in the past four years) of your clinical supervising and, at the outset of that year, must have achieved the following:

- ❖ at least five years of post-graduate practice before the start-date of contact with you (e.g. graduated on May 31, 1990, and became eligible to complete an Evaluator Package on June 1, 1996)
- ❖ hold state licensure in good standing at the highest clinical level, unless exempted by law or terms of government employment

**An Evaluator** must NOT be related to you.

Note: you are responsible for staying in touch with your Evaluators so that they mail their evaluations within two months of our receipt of your application materials.
